

Name of memorial: Dripsey Memorial

Place: Dripsey, Co. Cork

Address and map reference: On the Coachford road (R618) about 2km west of Dripsey (Ambush Crossroads)
Map reference: W 481 730 (Map 80).

Position: At roadside.

Description and dimensions: Limestone obelisk on a base approached by steps, with a low wall and steel gates. Height: 450cms, width: 100cms at base. Beside it is a slab with the inscription in English.
