

Name of memorial: Boer War Memorial

Position: At roadside.

Description and dimensions: Triple plinth with a statue of Victory central, seated figures of grieving young women on each side. On the sides and back of the plinth are three panels bearing the names of the fallen. There is also an inscription on the front and two relief panels of an officer and a soldier on the sides. Height: appx. 750cms. width: appx. 300cms., depth appx. 200cms.

Note: throughout the inscriptions on the memorial the letter “V” is used instead of “U”; a Victorian convention (Latin had no letter “U”). The correct spelling is given here.
